Over the years Camida has contributed to a range of different charitable events and causes in both the local community as well as the communities where staff members live.

### The Arts:

Camida has been a main sponsor of Clonmel Junction Arts Festival since the beginning. This has included musical events, theatre, a street party and much more.

### Sport:

Camida sponsor the Tipperary Ladies Football team since 2015.

At a local level, we have sponsored jerseys for sports clubs including Ardfinnan Children's Football, Slievenamon Celtic, Rockwell Rovers, New Inn, Moyle Rovers and Clonmel Rugby Club.

For the last few years, Camida has been the main sponsor of the Clonmel Duathlon.

Camida have also provided substantial contributory funding for Clonmel's new Sports Hub.

### Education:

Since 2014 Camida has been working with the secondary school Scoil Ruain providing support to both academia and sports in the school. Camida funds a hurling scholarship which goes towards kits for the players. We work in conjunction with a recruitment agency to provide interview skills talks for the Leaving Cert Applied class. We have hosted talks covering the areas of business and science as well as hosting students for their work experience. We also provide an academic scholarship each year to one student which supports them in their first year of college.

Camida has also given towards schools connected to staff members, which has included science equipment, iPads for remote learning and fundraising for school amenities.

**Annual donation:**

Since 2016, Camida has provided 2 substantial donations to two local charities each Christmas which have included Clonmel Soup Kitchen, Scoil Aonghusa, Camphill Community Carrick, Cuan Saor, C-Saw and Make A Change 2020 which assists the elderly and vulnerable in the local area. Our aim with this donation is to support a cause that may not receive much funding throughout the year and for some, Christmas is an especially hard time. These are always gratefully received, and we know the money is going to support those most in need.
