

Measuring our Sustainability Journey

In 2024, Camida started the process of measuring our carbon footprint to achieve a baseline on total emissions for 2023.

Our greenhouse gas (GHG) reduction targets align with the 1.5°C goal outlined in the Paris Agreement.

Our climate goals are also embedded in a wider sustainability strategy that considers the environment, society and governance with alignment to United Nations Sustainability Development Goals (SDGs)

To date we have measured the following GhG categories and associated carbon emissions are outlined below:
